The Grand Council Convention combines fraternal and professional educational opportunities with a chance to meet new Brothers and complete the business of the Fraternity.


- ► The theme for the meeting is 'Rise to the Challenge'
- ► Registration is open! Register here by May 15 to save \$125
 - ► Collegiate registration: \$325, Graduate registration: \$425
 - ► Includes anniversary banquet, opening reception, awards reception, Alpha reception, attendance at all continuing education, attendance at all forums, workshops and business meetings (brothers only), GCD luncheon (GCDs only), Guest breakfast (guests only), GCC favor
 - ► Rooms can be reserved now! Reserve your room by June 24th

- ► Arizona Grand Resort & Spa
 - ► All the rooms are suites with queen sized beds
 - ► Room rate of \$139/night for the standard suites
 - ► Room rate of \$439/night for 1 bedroom villas (includes full kitchen)
 - ▶ Resort fee of \$20/night per SUITE (not per person) includes:
 - ► Free parking, Fitness center access, in-suite internet, one daily in-suite pot of coffee, Oasis Water Park access (up to 4 wristbands)






- Arizona Grand Resort & Spa

 - ► Lots of food and shopping options nearby
 - ► A golf course, spa, and a 20,000 square foot athletic club are on property
 - ► The resort is immediately adjacent to the 17,000 acres of South Mountain Preserve, the largest municipal park in the world with numerous hiking trails
 - ► Located less than a 10 minute drive from the Phoenix Sky Harbor airport and free parking is included with your room resort fee



- ► Communications/Media/Contracts
 - ▶ While on campus, chapters often shorten their name to Kappa Psi but this may lead to miscommunication as well as legal concerns.
 - ► The only individuals that may speak on behalf of Kappa Psi are the Grand Regent and the Executive Director.
 - ► Only the International Executive Committee and the Central Office may enter contracts on behalf of Kappa Psi.
 - ► When communicating or drafting contracts on behalf of the chapter or province it is required to use the chapter or province name
 - ▶ e.g. Kappa Psi Alpha Beta Delta Chapter or Kappa Psi Omega Province
 - ► All chapter activities, formal communications, contracts, and financial accounts should be reviewed with your faculty advisors or faculty GCDs




- ► Trademark Use Policy created March 2022
 - ► Protects and ensures the appropriate use of the trademark words (Kappa Psi), Greek Letters (KΨ) and insignia that belong to the Fraternity
 - ► Chapters, Provinces and Members:
 - ► Must use vendors licensed by Affinity Consultants to design, make or sell Kappa Psi Items. A list of licensed vendors can be found at: www.greeklicensing.com
 - ► Are to refrain from using trademark or copyrighted items owned by external entities when designing products, logos or utilizing social media.
 - ► Examples include:
 - ► Using "March Madness" or "Super Bowl" for fundraising event
 - Including another company's logo in a Chapter report to promote an event

- Social media and professional communications
 - Reminder to not portray ritual information in public photos or communications
 - ▶ Be mindful that Kappa Psi photos and communications are professional and they follow the policy guidelines

- ▶ Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Training.
 - ▶ DEI training is available at no cost to our members through the Professional Fraternity Association.
 - ► Phase 1 of the PFA DEI Initiative (DEII) asks us to start with ourselves and explore unconscious bias.
 - ► Through the DEII, Kappa Psi Brothers have access to the Harvard Implicit Bias Assessments.
 - ► The selections through the PFA program assess unconscious bias in race, gender, career, and age.

- ► Finances and Taxes
 - ► Taxes for chapters and provinces should be filed annually
 - ▶ Best to file early to allow adequate time for resolution of concerns and to ensure appropriate filing for awards consideration

 - ► Alternatives to Venmo
 - ► <u>Givebutter.com</u> is an authorized vendor of Venmo and the platform may be used for electronic collection of funds with additional fees.
 - ► Zelle is an option without additional fees but is bank dependent

 - ► Editions back to 1904 may be found at kappapsiarchives.org
- ► Leaders and Legends
 - Clips of recordings have been posted to social media highlighting our Past Grand Regents
- ► Place a copy of your Chapter's historical records/pictures in your Chapter's history folder
 - Note: only the <u>chapter@kappapsi.org</u> email account may access the history folder
 - ► History Reports: Due 5/31/2022



- ► Keep up with your Chapter responsivities to the Central Office
 - ► Chapter Rosters Due October 15 and February 15
 - ▶ Dues for Collegiate Chapters Due Oct 15 and February 15
 - Submit Officer Rosters now and after next elections
